

Heidenau has been making tyres since 1946 and the **Heidenhau K76** is made from the company's "super compound rubber" which entails the mixing of different rubber types to produce the desired tyre. The K76 is a very hard tyre, this gives it mileage in excess of 20 000kms on a set but this also means that it takes very long to warm up and gives you just as poor grip in the rain. Although the deep grooves work fantastic in displacing water, the hard compound counts against. Caution is advised when riding in the rain. The tyre compares with the Mitas E-08, Bridgestone Battle Wing, Metzeler Tourance. It's good for everyday use, long rides, hard/loose gravel and little sand.
