

The Czech-based tyre manufacturer Mitas is well known for its off-road orientated tyres. The **Mitas E-07** is no exception. This tyre is close to being what is referred to as a 50/50 tyre. The key off-course is in the design of the “blocks” and V-shaped arrangement. Due to the tread pattern, these tyres are noisy, especially at the front. The tyre’s sidewalls are soft for this kind of tyre so extreme rocky areas should be approached with caution. There’s little feedback from the tyre due to its square shape. At 170km/h it has a low speed rating and it’s found to be more sensitive than other tyres to pressure, with the tyre physically disintegrating if under inflated or when exceeding the speed rating. These tyres are somewhat unpredictable on wet tarmac, but really come to life on hard/loose gravel, moderate sand and relatively effective in muddy conditions. Depending on how & where you ride a set of these tyres can last you about 15 000kms. All-in-all the E-07 is one of the most highly rated 50/50 (on-road/off-road)tyres around the globe.
