

With the **Pirelli Scorpion Trail 2**, Pirelli produced a tyre with better road holding abilities than the previous generation Scorpion Trail. The tyre is much sportier and sort of mimics the profile of Pirelli's Diablo tyres. Bi-compound technology is still employed and with a sport touring/ endure performance blended into one product one gets a tyre with top level handling throughout its lifetime. In our opinion this tyre is not such a big improvement on its predecessor with the only noticeable improvement being improved handling in the rain due to the tread pattern's more efficient water evacuation. That said, this tyre does take the Michelin Anakee3 and Metzeler Tourance Next head on. It also compares well with the Bridgestone A40 and Continental Trail Attack2. This tyre will give around 16000kms of mileage and is also good for hard gravel.
